

This rubric is found in the 1549 Prayer Book for Easter Day:

In the mornynge, afore Mattyns, the people beyng assembled in the Church, these Anthems shalbe fyrste solemnely song or sayed.

CHRIST rising again from the dead, nowe dieth not. Death from henceforth hath no power upon hym. For in that he dyed, he dyed but once to put away sinne: but in that he liueth, he liueth unto God. And so lykewyse, counte yourselves dead unto synne: but lyuyng unto God in Christe Jesus our Lorde.  
Alleluya, Alleluya.

CHRISTE is risen againe: the firste fruytes of them that slepe: for seyng that by man came death: by man also commeth the resurreccion of the dead. For as by Adam all men do dye, so by Christe all menne shalbe restored to lyfe. Alleluya.

The same anthems are given in the 1552 Prayer Book, replacing the Venite at mattins, but without the Alleluyas. This points to 1549-1552 as the period of composition. However this work is in Tallis' most mature style, and was probably written for the Chapel Royal in the time of Elizabeth I. Interestingly, the first Alleluyas are omitted, and the final one is detachable.

The Easter Anthems have been transposed up one tone on account of the pitch change. They could be sung a semitone lower than this edition.
